

4. Officers are instructed to observe a subject's pulse, blood pressure and performance on various divided attention exercises, which is useful in determining if a person is under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

5. DRE Training consists of nine days of classroom work where officers learn about specific drug categories, physiology and work to enhance their standard field sobriety testing skills.

6. Minnesota's DRE Program has been managed by the State Patrol since its inception in 1991. Currently there are 197 DRE officers in Minnesota representing 92 agencies.

7. On May 9, 2012, the DRE Program was suspended to further evaluate the DRE Program and certification process.


8. Presently, certified drug recognition experts are employed throughout the state but the State Patrol is not currently conducting any DRE training programs.
