Cecil,

I had a chat with Crystal Jones on what some of the bright spots of this NASCO project may be. She mentioned that it may be the experience that Lockheed brings to the table from the Global Trade activity with the military. They apparently have been involved in tracking goods for the military over time and they are trying to institute some of this along the NASCO corridor.

You may also want to be aware the New York is about to get engaged on a project called CVII, where they are going to focus on all the reader sites that exist and use those to the advantage of making law enforcement smarter as it relates to prescreening CMV's for safety and S&W requirements. They are looking at hooking up CVO sites and toll sites and other reader sites that may be out there to help in more efficient enforcement but also helping with freight mobility. NASCO could take a page out of the lesson book on this.

Also, in New Orleans next week you will see a presentation on smart roadside that will show what Florida is doing on linking and connecting reader sites that can help on enforcement and on freight mobility. Florida is also looking at linking in Ports to the equation. I am working with them on the Port of Jacksonville project that is checking departing weights of trucks and letting them know if they need a permit. If they ignore the permit warning then guess who is waiting for them on the other side of the fence? You guessed right. Lots of good things going on and looking to hear some of your thoughts and getting those aired through AASHTO. I know that Tony is looking forward to visiting with you next week on many of these activities. I've also copied in Mike Akridge from Florida who plans on being in New Orleans. I also copied Jeff Secrist and Julie Lane, our partners from FMCSA. Jeff will not be attending AASHTO but Julie will be there. We can use your help and experiences and need Minnesota's input. Thanks.
